**John 15:2, 6** "Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away"

**Acts 5:1-11** (Rev 21:8) Ananias and Sapphira

**Acts 8:12-13** (Mk 16:16), **20-23** "Simon fell"

**I Corinthians 8:11** "shall the weak brother perish"

**I Corinthians 9:27** lest Paul "should be a castaway (reprobate)"

**I Corinthians 10:12** "take heed lest he fall"

**Galatians 5:4** "fallen from grace" (It's hard to fall from grace if you have never been a recipient of the grace of God!)

**I Timothy 5:12** "Having condemnation, because they have cast off their first faith"

**Hebrews 2:1-4**

**Hebrews 3:6-4:13**, particularly **3:12-14** (3:12 "in departing from the living God" Hebrews 1 indicates that 3:12 is talking about people who have been saved.) **& 4:11**

**Hebrews 6:4-8** "If they shall fall away"

**Hebrews 10:26-31** "if we sin willfully ... fall into the hands of the living God" (Verse 29 is particularly helpful in this regard because it obviously describes the "elect")

**Hebrews 12:25**

**James 5:19-20** "save a soul (brother) from death"

**II Peter 1:9-11** "If ye do these things, ye shall never fall"

**II Peter 2:20-22** "latter end is worse with them than the beginning"

**I John 1:9** "if we confess our sins," we will be forgiven

**Revelation 3:5** "blot out his name out of the book of life"
