Attitudes toward ... Service

Thieves	What's yours is mine, and I'll take it
Lawyer	What's mine is mine, and I'll keep it... unless I <i>have</i> to give it up.
Priest and Levite	What's mine is mine, and I'll keep it – even if you're at death's door!
Samaritan	What's mine is yours; I'll give it to you freely.

Attitudes toward ... Service

Thieves	What the most evil I can I get away with?
Lawyer	What's the least good I can get away with?
Priest and Levite	What can I avoid?
Samaritan	What more can I do?

Compare the sacrifices that the Samaritan made – giving of himself, sacrificing time, self and resources, motivated only by love – to the sacrifices Jesus made for us all. (Philippians 2)
